Breakfast items are provided for all the exhibitors and lunches are provided only for the workers. There are some fast food restaurants within driving distance of the school.

DART donations

DACC (DART) donates 10% of each trial's profits to a non-breed specific dog related charity.

Move-Ups

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that a written request is made to the Trial Secretary no later than 6 pm on Monday before the trial. Day to day move-ups will be allowed provided the Trial Secretary receives them by the end of the trial day (before Trial Secretary leaves the trial site.) There will be no move-ups in the morning before the start of the trial.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all qualifiers.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of each class. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. There will be no contact obstacle familiarization for Novice.

Eligibility

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Class Information

Descriptions and entry requirements are listed in Ch. 2 and Ch. 8 of the "AKC Regulations for Agility Trials" amended 09/01/06.

Height Divisions			MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION
Height divisions for each class are listed in Ch. 2, sec.3 and Ch. 8, sec. 7 of the "AKC Regulations for Agility Trials" amended 9/1/06.			Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process			
When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured.			

Preferred Class

Any dog (at least 15 months old – see Eligibility requirements above) may enter Preferred Classes. A dog entered in Preferred will jump 4" lower than its regular jump height and have 5 seconds in time added to the regular Standard Course Time. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter the Novice level regardless of their previous title level in the Regular classes. Dogs in the Preferred Class must jump their Preferred jump height. They may not jump higher. Dogs cannot be entered in Regular and Preferred Classes on the same weekend. Dogs may switch back and forth between Regular and Preferred but not at the same trial.

Can you HELP?

It takes a lot of people to put on a successful agility trial. If you work a class we'll provide you with a free lunch. You can earn DART Points that can be used at future trials.

Safety, Behavior, and Liability

- This trial will be conducted under the American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials. For copies of the Regulations, write the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606-3390 or visit their website online at: www.akc.org.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. DACC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- DACC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against DACC or any official thereof.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to inform the gate stewards of possible conflicts before their turn.
- Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will be held outdoors on grass. Ring size will be 100' x 100'.
- No dogs allowed in the restrooms. Please pick up after your dogs.
- **All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring or when in designated warm-up areas.**

Refunds

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- Full entry fees will be refunded in an entry is pulled before the closing date/time.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- DACC is under no obligation to offer refunds for duplicate entries for the same dog.
- Half of entries will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the close of entries, if the Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal (USPS or email) by 8 pm on Monday before the trial. Bitches in season will not be allowed on AKC showgrounds. Owners requesting refunds for bitches in season may be asked to provide a statement from a veterinarian that the bitch in question is in season on the date of the trial. Refunds apply to the affected bitch only, not for all dogs entered by the bitch's owner and/or traveling companions.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- No refunds for overpayment of entry fees will be made for \$10.00 or less.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776.
